ALCONA COUNTY PROPOSALS

911 OPERATING SURCHARGE RENEWAL

For the period beginning on July 1, 2017 and continuing through the month of June in the year 2021 shall Alcona County be authorized to assess a monthly surcharge of up to \$3.00 (not to exceed \$3.00) on the monthly billings of landline, wireless and VOIP service suppliers within the geographic boundaries of Alcona County to exclusively finance the equipment and operating costs of the 911 Emergency Telephone Answering and Dispatch System within Alcona County? This is a renewal of a previously voter approved authorization that will expire before the effective date of this authorization.

COUNTYWIDE DRUG INTERDICTION MILLAGE INCREASE

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes that may be assessed against all property in Alcona County be increased, as provided for in Article 9, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution, and the Alcona County Board of Commissioners be authorized to levy a new millage not to exceed 0.15 mill (\$0.15 per thousand dollars) of taxable value of such property for a period of four (4) years beginning with the levy to be made on December 1, 2016, estimated to generate \$110,395.00 in the first year, disbursed to Alcona County for the purpose of enhancing law enforcement efforts in county wide drug interdiction, funding the drug interdiction program known as the Huron Undercover Narcotics Team and preserving and protecting the safety of the citizens of Alcona County?

ALPENA-MONTMORENCY-ALCONA ESD PROPOSALS

SPECIAL EDUCATION MILLAGE RENEWAL

This proposal will allow the intermediate school district to continue to levy special education millage previously approved by the electors.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Alpena-Montmorency-Alcona Educational Service District, Michigan, be renewed for 1.3318 mills (\$1.3318 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2017 to 2026, inclusive, to provide funds for the education of students with a disability; the estimate of the revenue the intermediate school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2017 is approximately \$2,474,661 from local property taxes authorized herein (this is a renewal of millage that expires with the 2016 tax levy)?
