**Motion by Gauthier, seconded by Brege, to approve the following ballot language for the ambulance millage renewal to be placed on the August 7, 2018 Primary ballot:**

**ALCONA COUNTY AMBULANCE MILLAGE RENEWAL**

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Alcona County of 1 mill (\$1.00 per thousand dollars), be renewed at the original voted 1 mill (\$1.00 per thousand dollars of taxable value) and levied for four (4) years 2018 through 2021, raising an estimated \$754,999.00 in the first year the millage is levied, for the sole purpose of providing funding to operate and maintain the Alcona County Ambulance Service?
